

First, Thank You to the numerous Property Owners' that immediately jumped in to help clear roadways on Friday morning. Your service was absolutely critical to opening the roadways and gate access points.

On Friday, C&R Tree Service was onsite at 9:00 am to begin clearing the roadways to make them passable. That was the goal for Friday and was accomplished by the end of the day.

Saturdays and Sundays goal by C&R was to take individual Property Owner calls and to assist with removal of trees from damaged rooftops.

WPPOA Maintenance was out Saturday helping to clear driveways and roadways.

As of Monday morning, the next step and priority goal is to remove what is leaning and what was topped but not fallen, and what is protruding into the roadway. This will take several days to weeks to accomplish.

If you have a tree leaning that you are concerned about from POA Common Area ONLY, please email the wppoa@wppoa.com address. This address is being used specifically for these issues. Please provide as much detail as possible in order to accurately prioritize. With the high volume that we are receiving, you will not receive an individual response but will be added to our list. You will receive an auto-response that confirms receipt of your concern.

Cold Creek will begin removing smaller trees and debris remediation from Common Areas, including sidewalks today. Please note that many trees along the sidewalks are dangerous still and risk falling or dropping more limbs. Walk cautiously and be alert to the potential dangers.

If you have trees from a neighbors' property or from the clubs, you will need to reach out to them directly. The WPPOA cannot oversee private property tree removals.

If you have a tree on your roof, regardless of where it has fallen from, you will have to contact your private insurance provider to assess damage and provide you with the next steps for remediation.

At that this time, we do not know about city pick-up. We will discuss with them in the coming days and provide updates as we have them. Do not dump your debris, etc. on Common Areas. Additionally, please put your debris in your yard at the curb and keep the roadways as clear as possible. We will lift the Covenant restrictions on lawn debris placement indefinitely.

We will continue to provide updates as necessary and as we receive more information.
