

Update 10/15/2024

The City of Aiken expects to begin debris clean-up of residential properties this week. They will be using an outside vendor so please do not be alarmed when you do not see City trucks collecting the debris. The residential haul off of will not have an additional cost to you. This is expected to take several passes and will be months to complete debris haul-off totally.

Debris should be placed in front of your home and not extended into the roadway. Debris piles must be placed so that the two vehicles can pass safely.

There will be a cost for hauling debris from POA Common Areas. If you continue to dump your debris on common areas, please note that is significantly driving our cost for removal up. Please remove your debris from Common Areas and stop this action immediately.

Garbage pick-up will be comingled until further notice. The city is facing delays so receptacles should be placed at the curb until they are emptied. You do not need to move them while awaiting pick-up.

The Chukker Creek Gate remains closed for entry. We understand the inconvenience and are trying to find a solution. Unfortunately, we are short-staffed with security officers this week and are unable to pull a guard from another post. We are continuing attempts to have a guard during school hours but have been unsuccessful to this point.

Since the roadways in Woodside are still full of debris, please drive carefully around the road hazards
