The Chukker Creek Gate is open to exiting traffic only until further notice. The entry gate arm sustained extensive damage and will need to be totally replaced.

Garbage and Recycling pick-up will continue to be co-mingled indefinitely. This means you can put both cans out, they will pick them both up.

We do not have an update on debris pick-up. As soon as we have a starting timeframe for debris haul-off, an email will be sent.

**PLEASE PUT YOUR DEBRIS IN YOUR YARD. NOT IN THE ROAD.** Debris in the roadway is a major safety hazard. We will begin sending direct notices to those that have placed debris in the road with a warning. If debris is not removed, you may be assessed a fine. **PLEASE DO NOT MOVE YOUR DEBRIS TO COMMON AREAS, ANY OF THE GOLF COURSES, OR VACANT LOTS.** This will not expedite pick-up. These are private properties. If you place on the common area or golf courses you may be assessed a fine. Please note the reason for this requirement is because it is a major safety concern for vehicles, pedestrians, and bicyclists. Criteria for non-acceptable piles are that the piles are covering a lane and that two vehicles cannot safely pass at one time. An example of an acceptable pile is below...
